

A Streets Committee Meeting of the City of Gray, Georgia was held on Friday, June 26, 2020 in the conference room at City Hall.

Present: Mayor Ed Barbee, Mayor Pro Tem James Collins, Council Members Benny Gray, David Tufts and Terry Favors, City Superintendent Frank Ross, Assistant City Superintendent Cheyenne Morgan, Public Works Manager Chris Neal, City Clerk Cindy Yancey and Assistant City Clerk Ashley Roberson.

Guests: Matt Smith with Carter & Sloope, Sherri Rollins and Earl Queen.

Streets Committee Chairman David Tufts called the meeting to order at 10:00am.

Streets Committee:

- Butler Hall/ Ross Street Drainage Plan
 - Engineer Matt Smith with Carter and Sloope reviewed the plan to correct the drainage issues on Ross Street surrounding Butler Hall.
 - Mr. Smith will put together specifications for the project and obtain quotes to bring back to Council for review.
- Stone Brooke Drive
 - Engineer Matt Smith explained that he has spoken with City Superintendent Frank Ross regarding an issue with a corroded pipe on Stone Brooke Drive that needs repair. The proposals that he has received were: Water & Sons \$50,000.00, Sellers \$79,000.00 and he is waiting for one from Pyles which he believes will be around \$100,000.00.
 - Mr. Smith believes that they do not all have the same scope of work, therefore, he will put together specifications and put the project out for bid. City policy requires anything over \$20,000.00 to be sealed bids.
- LMIG Streets
 - Assistant City Superintendent Cheyenne Morgan has looked at the streets that were listed on the LMIG application and ranked them by priority: Graystone Drive, Autumn Ridge Trail, Howard Court, Amanda Drive and Amy Lane.
 - After discussion, it was decided to repave the three worst streets using the LMIG funds along with money from the streets budget: Graystone Drive, Autumn Ridge Trail and Howard Court.
 - Councilman Tufts made the recommendation to use Reeves Construction due to their low bid and being a reputable company. This will be added to the July Council Meeting for approval.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
