

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Mayor and Council for the City of Gray, Georgia was held on Monday, February 4, 2019 at 6:00 PM in the D.V. Childs Civic Center.

Mayor Barbee called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Councilman Tufts gave the invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Fulford made a motion, seconded by Councilman Tufts, and unanimously voted to approve the February 4, 2019 agenda.
