

A Personnel Committee Meeting of the City of Gray, Georgia was held on Wednesday, May 25, 2022, 2022 in the conference room at City Hall.

Personnel Committee:

Mayor Pro Tem James Collins called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

1. Pay Rates

- Mayor Pro Tem James Collins proposed a 4% pay increase to council for all City employees due to recent inflation.
- City Clerk Cindy Yancey advised council if there is a 4% increase the pay scale will have to be revised. The current pay scale is set on 1.5% pay increase increments. She recommended doing a 3% or 4.5% pay increase to kept from entire pay scale being revised.
- Chief Adam Lowe stated he will revise the current pay scale to reflect the 4% increase.
- It was consensus of council to add this to the June Council meeting agenda for a vote.

Councilman Tufts made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fulford, and unanimously voted to close the Personnel Committee Meeting and go into Executive Session regarding personnel issues.

The Personnel Committee Meeting resumed.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
